



Student Dress-Up Day *Wednesday December 20th*



To celebrate our final day of school during the Advent Season, students will be allowed to dress-up for the day....please see guidelines below:

Girls:

Dresses or skirts may be worn – Skirt/dress length should meet the knee.

There are no exceptions to this.

Shoulders and upper arms must be covered throughout the school day.

Leggings may be worn with a skirt, dress, or top that meets the knee.

Leggings should not be worn alone.

*Shoes with a heel are **NOT** acceptable. Flats are suggested.*

Khaki pants

Button down, collared shirt

Polo/golf shirt

Turtleneck shirt

Sweater

Neck ties may be worn but are not necessary

Nice athletic shoes
