



St. Andrew has modified its medication policy to adhere to the medication policy issued by the Diocese of Columbus (Policy Number 5141.0)

- 1) Prescription as well as over- the- counter medication must be sent to school in the original container or packaging. The container or packaging must include the name of student, medication, and physician, along with dosage.
- 2) All medication must be brought to and kept in the school nurse's office.
- 3) When medication is to be administered at school, the parent or guardian must stop at the school nurses office and sign a permission form, releasing and holding school personnel harmless from any and all liability resulting directly and indirectly from the administration and use of medication.
- 4) The school reserves the right, with parental consent, to consult with the student's physician regarding medication.
- 5) The school will not administer over-the-counter (non-prescription) drugs, unless there is a signed permission form.
- 6) As a courtesy to parent, Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen, and Lozenges will be administered with the parent's signature.
